

# MONROE COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES


June 5, 2023

Non-aerial fireworks will be allowed for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday. Any "missile" and skyrocket" type of fireworks is prohibited pursuant to RSMo. 49.266.




